GET READY FOR SAN ANTONIO!

Once again the **South Texas Longhorn Association** will be joining with the **San Antonio Livestock Show & Rodeo** for The Longhorn Show on **Saturday, February 6, 2010** We will be having a Youth Haltered Show and an Open Non-Haltered Show. This Premium Show attracts many first-time exhibitors, as well as the seasoned veterans. Last year over one million visitors passed through the turn-stiles at the San Antonio Livestock Show & Rodeo. In recent years, we have seen the show stands full and crowds of as many as five deep around the arena during the Longhorn Shows. This show provides a great opportunity to showcase your Texas Longhorn cattle.

Cattle will arrive on Friday, February 5, 2010 and may leave as early as Saturday following the shows or as late as Monday by 6 P.M. (Non-haltered must be out by Sunday at 9 A.M.). This is a great opportunity for the Youth to show without missing any days of classes.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS DECEMBER 1, 2009

All fees and entry forms are to be sent to South Texas Longhorn Association so that they may be properly processed and a show program may be generated. A copy of each animal's Registration Certificate must accompany the entry forms. **Remember to complete the W-9 form on the back of the "2009 Open Livestock Entry Form" (W-9 information must be completed in the event you are due a Premium from the show).**

SHOW ENTRY FEE: **\$45.00 per animal per show**

(This includes the San Antonio Fee, the TLBAA fee, and STLA cost to cover Youth prizes, printing of the show program and advertising.)

Parking pass fee: \$24.00 each, good for week one (2/5/09 – 2/14/09) only (see entry form bottom left) Daily parking passes are available for \$8 and \$10 – but this does not get you in the barn area.

Gate Pass: Each owner is issued one gate pass, **additional passes are \$20.00** and are good for grounds admission for the entire run of the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo.

Daily grounds admission is as follows: Adults \$5.00, Senior Citizens (60 and over) \$3.00, children 2-11 years of age \$2.00, and children under 2 years of age are free (continued)

GENERAL INFORMATION

All cattle must be TLBAA registered.

San Antonio does require health papers. (See the link on the STLA website)

San Antonio pays a show premium to the class winner. Any premium will be paid to the person listed as the EXHIBITOR on the ***2010 Open Livestock Entry Form***.

If entering the Youth Haltered Show and the EXHIBITOR is different than the Youth showing the animal, please list the Youth showing the animal in parenthesis next to the EXHIBITOR name, as we need to know the name of the Youth showing the animal. If the same EXHIBITOR and/or Youth is entering/showing more than two animals, you may add the additional animals on the "*Animal Information Form*".

All youth exhibitors must be members of the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA) Texas Longhorn Breeders of Tomorrow (TLBT). For more information on joining TLBT, please contact the TLBAA office at 817-625-6241.
