**GUIDELINES**

**Central Life Sciences – Altosid IGR** will be awarding two \$750 scholarships in May 2010 to be administered through the South Texas Longhorn Association’s Youth Scholarship Program. To apply, students must meet all of the following guidelines noted below to be eligible for receiving one of these special scholarships. Funding for the scholarships will be paid directly to the university or college you select.

**Scholarship Criteria:**

- Applicant must be a 2010 high-school graduate and must have shown in at least 50% of the STLA-sponsored youth shows during their last four (4) years of high school. Provide verification list of your participation on page 3.
- Applicant must request, complete, and return the application form and any associated application documents during a period between February 1 and April 15, 2010.
- Applicant must complete a typed essay (minimum 300 words) on the topic:  
*“The Texas Longhorn Legacy: Learning from the Past to Build a Strong Future”*
- Applicant must agree to issue a thank-you letter to the membership of STLA within 45 days of receiving notice of the award of this scholarship. This should be mailed in care of the current STLA President.
- Applicant must agree to issue a thank-you letter within 45 days of receipt of award of scholarship to Central Life Sciences, Attn: Mark Newberg, 1501 East Woodfield Road, Suite 200, West, Schaumburg, IL 60173. Additionally, a copy of the thank-you letter sent to Central Life Sciences must be sent to the Board of Directors of the South Texas Longhorn Association, in care of the current STLA President.
